- The prevention of pollution and more efficient use of resources, by mitigating process related impacts in the natural, built, and socio-economic environment in order to limit our impact on Global Warming and Climate Change.
- Continual improvement of all related programmes and standards to enhance organizational HSE performance.
- Compliance with all related legal provisions and corporate standards through routine compliance assessments as well as ensuring full compliance with them.
- Elimination of reasonably possible hazards and reduce Occupational Health and Safety risks.

- Routine review and monitoring of HSE programmes and overall performance.
