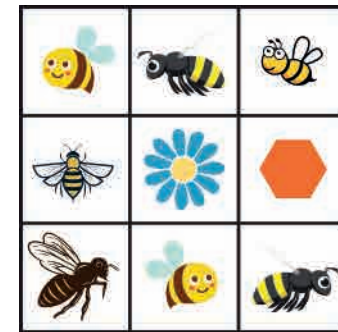
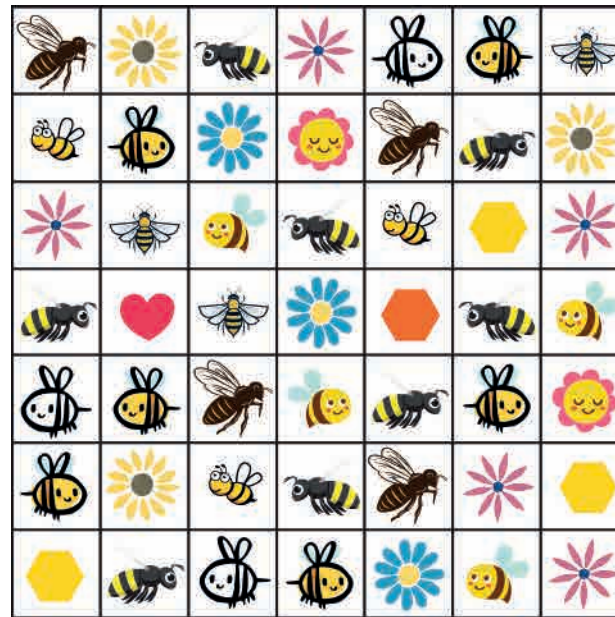

The average worker bee lives for just 5 or 6 weeks – but the queen can live up to 5 years.



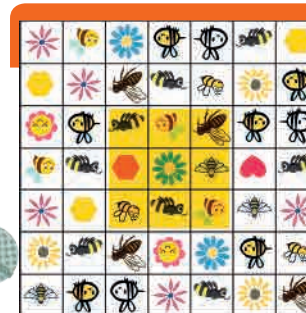

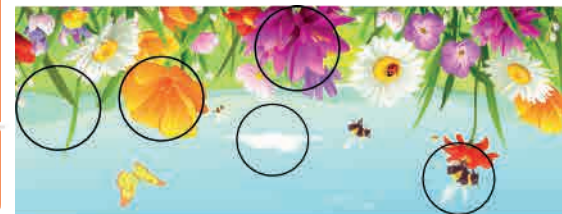

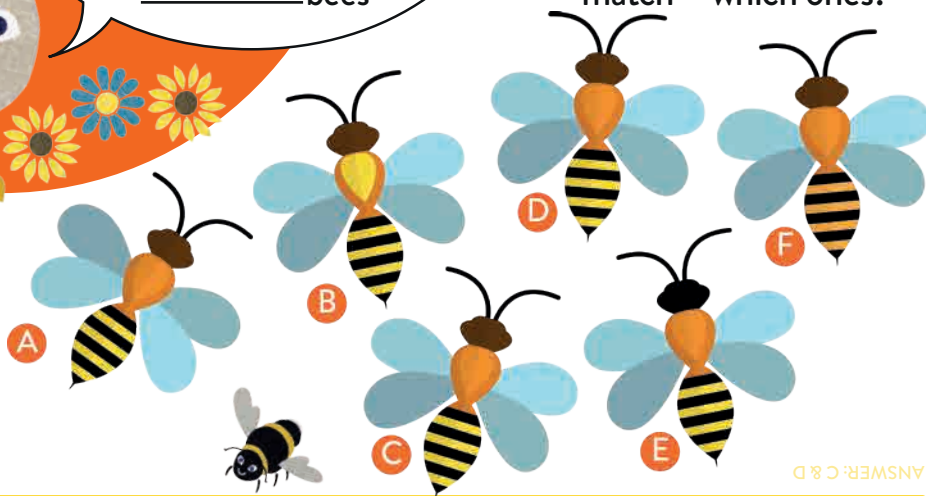

There are 2 bees here that match – which ones?

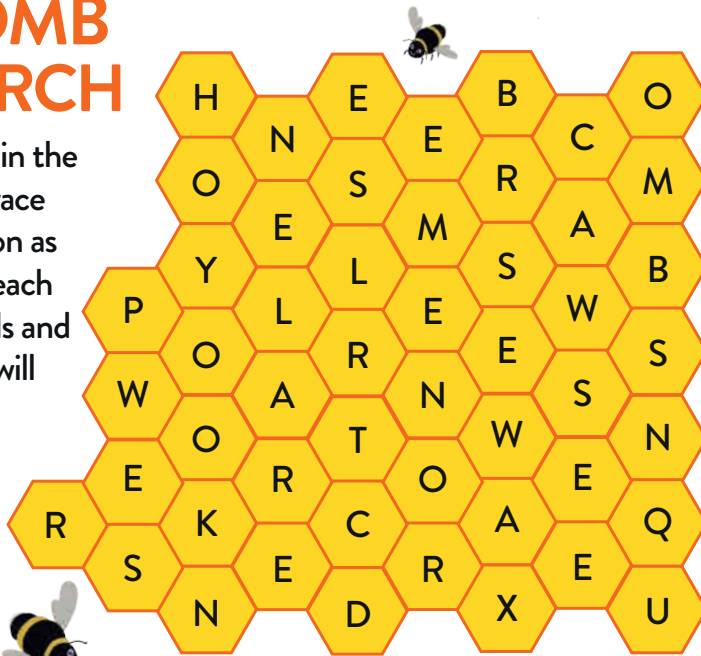
