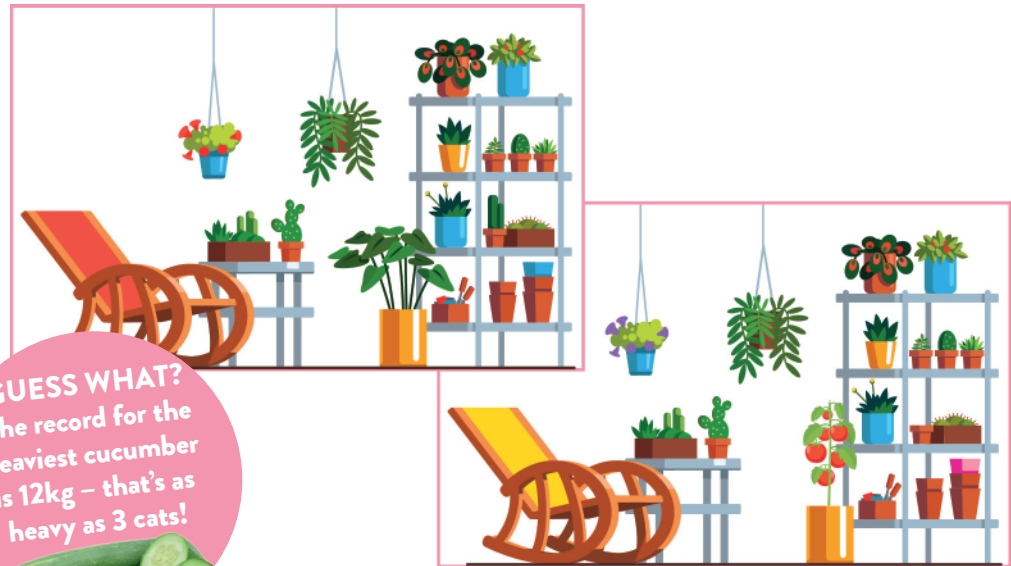
GUESS WHAT?

There are 5 changes in these pictures: can you find them all?

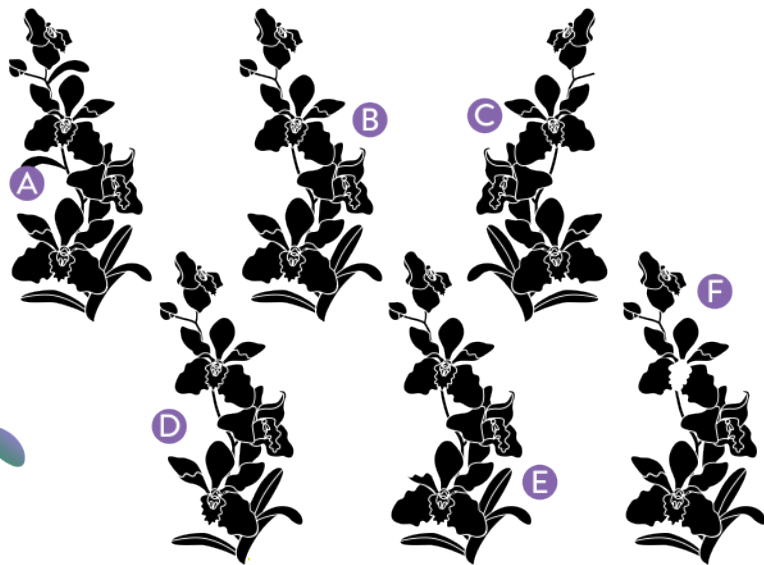


GUESS WHAT?

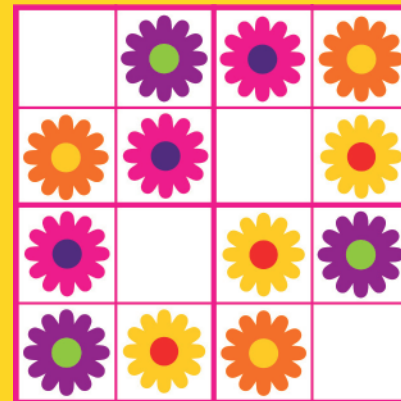
WORD SEARCH
