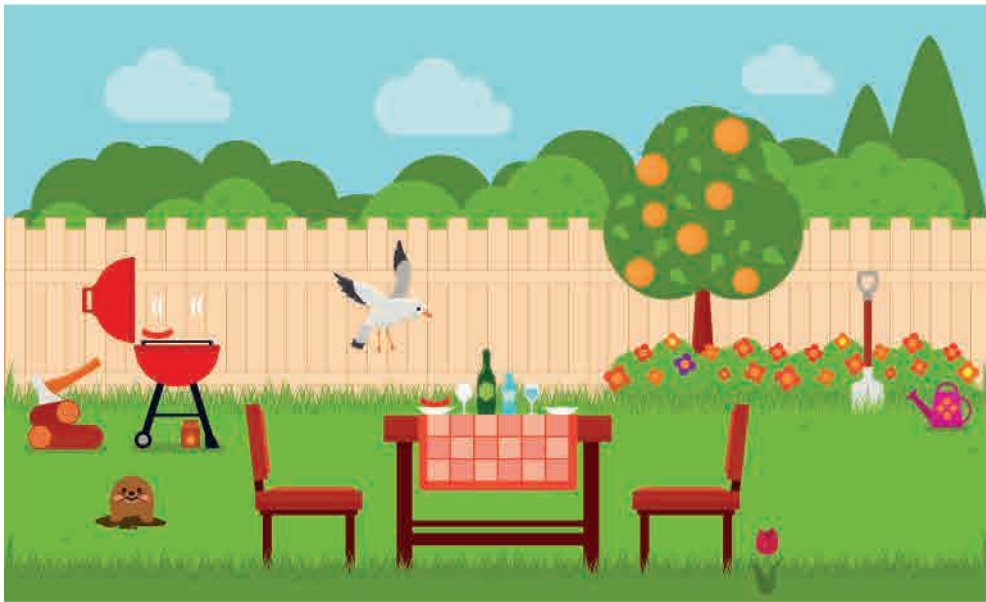

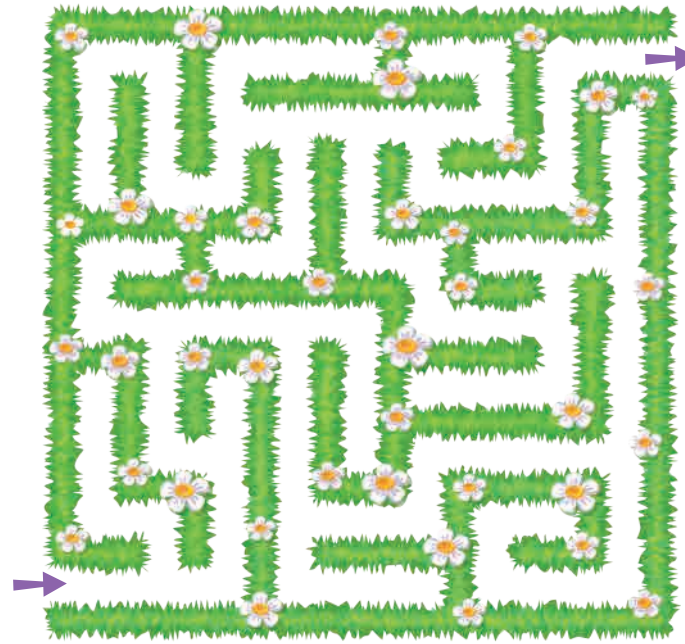
SPOT THE DIFFERENCE

Can you find your way through the grassy maze?



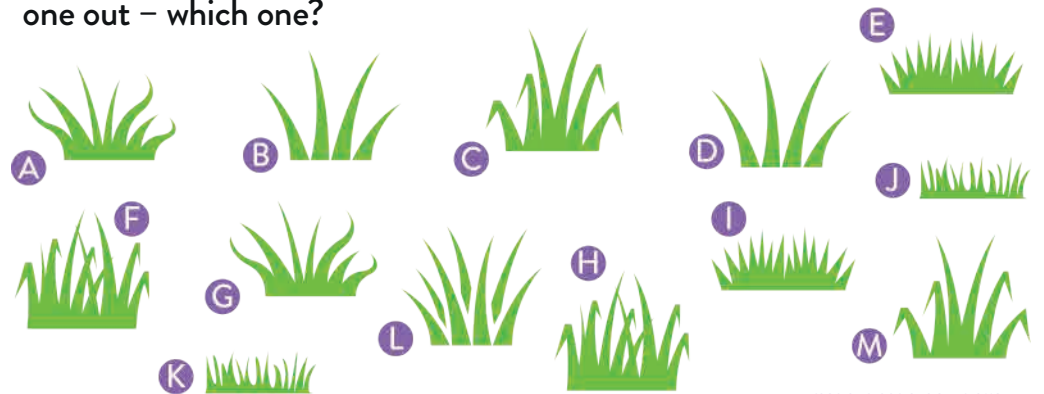
GUESS WHAT?
