

Grow tomatoes from seed


They're so easy to sow, and grow


Growing your own tomatoes is deliciously easy, plus it's always fun to harvest your own crop. Home-grown toms aren't just sweeter and juicier, planting from seed is economical, too.

Choose your favourites, from small cherry tomatoes to big beefsteak varieties, and simply plant them into small pots between February and April. They'll happily grow in a propagator or a warm, frost-free conservatory or greenhouse. You can then plant them out in containers when all risk of frost has passed.

Fill your home with the aroma of fresh herbs

This DIY herb bowl is ideal for brightening up your kitchen or dining room with some greenery. Use it as a centrepiece for your dining table or keep it handy on your kitchen counter and have herbs at your fingertips to add to all your favourite home cooked meals.

In our herb bowl, we've used thyme Silver Queen, common thyme, oregano, lavender and rosemary, but you can also use basil, chives, mint or parsley as these are some of the easiest herbs to grow. Just make sure you're choosing herbs with flavours and scents you enjoy.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Your choice of herbs – 3 to 5 herbs works perfectly and makes the planter look full and flourishing
- Medium to large plant pot
- Multi-purpose peat free compost
- Watering can

METHOD

- 1. Fill half of your pot with compost.
- 2. Remove the herbs from their plastic containers, then position them in the pot, placing taller ones at the back. If the containers are biodegradable then there's no need to remove them and you can plant directly into the compost.
- 3. Fill any remaining gaps with compost and water well.
- 4. Place in a sunny spot in your home, like a bright dining room or kitchen counter.

Early spring is the ideal time to repot your houseplants as they enter the growing season. The key things to remember are to choose the right size of pot with adequate drainage holes; use the most appropriate potting mix; water your plant 24 hours beforehand; and take care to handle its roots carefully in the process to avoid transplant shock and keep it happy as it adjusts to its new surroundings.

HOW TO Create your own spring centrepiece

Bring the new season into your home with a spring-themed centrepiece, made with everyone's favourite spring flowers.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Your favourite spring potted flowers and bulbs - we've used Galanthus Flore Pleno Snowdrops, Hyacinth Pink Pearl and Hyacinth Blue Pearl
- A medium to large plant pot
- Multi-purpose peat free compost
- Horticultural gravel/grit
- Watering can

METHOD

- 1. Pick your pot pastel yellows, pinks and blues are perfectly spring-themed, or choose a more neutral colour to really make your chosen flowers pop.
- 2. Scatter gravel at the bottom of your pot to help with drainage.
- 3. Arrange your choice of potted spring bulbs on top.
- 4. Fill the remaining gaps with compost and gently firm to make sure everything is sitting comfortably.
- 5. Water when your soil feels dry.


