Four Seasons in a Year

Each season has its own weather, but some countries don't experience all four



It's All In The Tilt

The seasons change as the Earth tilts farther or closer to the sun



Christmas in Summer

Countries south of the equator, such as Australia, have the opposite seasons to us in the Northern Hemisphere



Spot the Signs

Nature has many ways of telling us that the seasons are changing, including birds migrating or days getting longer

FUN FACTS ABOUT THE SEASONS



Everything equal

The equinox happens twice a year, when the days and nights are approximately the same length

The longest day, the longest night

The solstices also occur twice a year, when we have our longest day and night

The changing seasons can affect everything from the weather to how we feel
