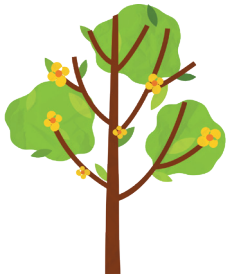
An orchard through the seasons

What happens?

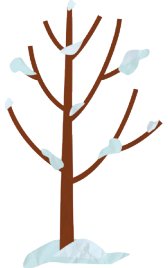
Fruit starts to grow and ripen; wildlife creates a buzz all around

Some of the things you might not know about orchards.

Orchard trees need lots of sun and space to grow well.

Did you know?
There are over 7,500 different types of apples

Some orchards are hundreds of years old!

Apple trees can take 5-8 years to bear fruit.

A single apple tree can grow up to 500 apples a year.

Apples belong to the rose family - so do pears, cherries, and plums.

Traditional orchards are habitats for rare or endangered creatures.
