
















- Retain these instructions for future reference.

- This product is intended for a maximum weight of 110kg per seat. Do not exceed this weight.

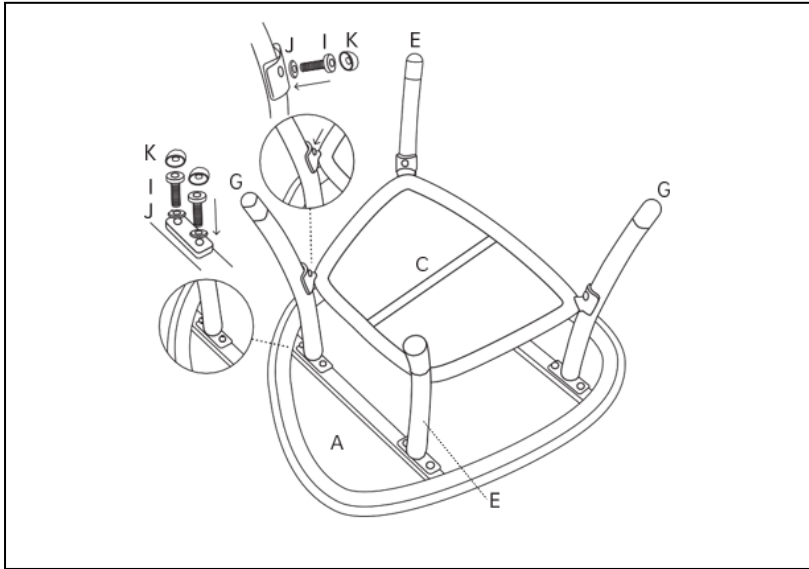

ASSEMBLY IMAGES & STEPS

Step 1

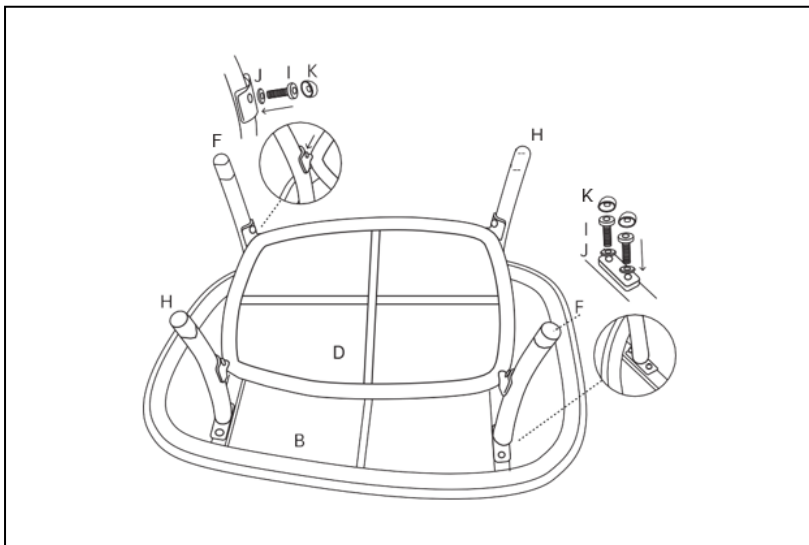


Use bolts (I) and washers (J) to connect Table Leg 1 (E) x2 and Table Leg 3 (G) x2, to Small Table Shelf (C) with Allen Key (N). Note each leg goes in the diagonally opposite corner from its partner. Leave bolts loose until after the next step.

Now use bolts (I) and washers (J) to connect each leg to Small Table Top (A). Tighten all bolts with Allen Key (N) and add Plastic Bolt Cap (K) to each bolt.

Turn the assembled table onto its feet and place Small Table Glass (L) on top of suction cups.

Step 2

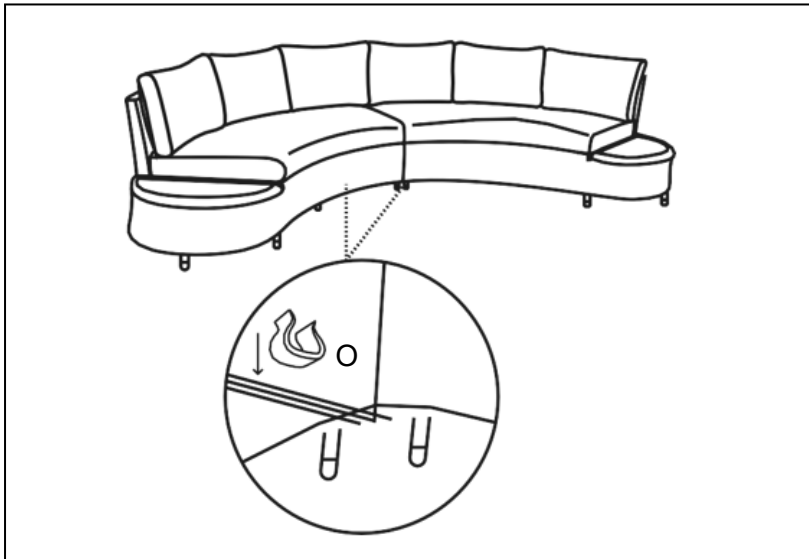


Use bolts (I) and washers (J) to connect Table Leg 2 (F)x2 and Table Leg 4 (H) x2 to Large Table Shelf (D) with Allen Key (N). Note each leg goes in the diagonally opposite corner from its partner. Leave bolts loose until after the next step.

Now use bolts (I) and washers (J) to connect each leg to Large Table Top (B). Tighten all bolts with Allen Key (N) and add Plastic Bolt Cap (K) to each bolt.

Turn the assembled table onto its feet and place Large Table Glass (M) on top of suction cups.

Step 3



Ensure you are positioning both seat sections on a flat, stable surface. When you are happy with the location of furniture, attach “U” clips (O) to secure furniture together, before arranging your seat and back cushions.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Please keep away from sources of extreme heat and naked flames, including any cushions or seat pads.
- Please note that synthetic weave product may sag under direct sunlight. This is a normal occurrence and the weave will return to its normal state upon cooling. To help reduce this occurrence, we recommend using a parasol where possible.
- Warm soapy water is recommended to clean the product. Please note that the cushions or seat pads must only be washed by sponge and left to dry naturally.
- Throughout the winter months, bring product indoors where possible or use a breathable furniture cover. Failure to do so may invalidate your warranty.
