WORLD RECORD HOLDERS

As we're learning all about how to help plants grow big and strong, here are some of the biggest plants in the world!

Stinking Corpse Lily This plant produces the world's biggest flower, but it smells really bad





Splendid Pitcher Plant Instead of flies, these massive carnivorous plants eat lizards and rats!

Corpse Flower Another smelly one! This flower can be up to 3 metres and uses smell to attract insects



Cardon Cactus Mostly found in Mexico, these cacti can live 300 years and grow up to 19 metres

Giant Sequoia Tree These huge trees can grow 85 metres high and 8 metres wide



Neptune grass An 8km colony of this grass was found near Ibiza and is thought to be 3,000 years old!



You can stop seedlings getting fungus or disease by adding a pinch of cinnamon to the soil

FABULOUS FERTILISER
